- 3. Have a minimum “B” (3.0) GPA**
- 4. Have a permanent residence in Kern County**
- 5. Be enrolled in college this fall, 2025 and carry a full-time student load (12 semester units).**
- 6. Attend the *Kern Ag Foundation Scholarship Awards Night Program* on Wednesday, May 6, 2026.**
